| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. One minute prior to game time, the Team A coach changes a designated starter. It is not due to necessity. The official assesses a technical foul to Team A. At half time the coach has the scorer change a player's number in the scorebook and notifies an official. The official assesses no penalty. Is the official correct?</li> <li>2. The official directs A-1 to the bench because A-1 is bleeding. The coach indicates that he/she is going to replace A-1. The official instructs the timer to start the 15-second replacement interval. The coach now requests a time-out to keep A-1 in the game. The official denies the request. Is the official correct?</li> <li>3. During a throw-in by Team A on the end line, Team A players line up parallel to the end line and within three feet of the boundary line. The captain of Team B requests that his/her teammates have a position between each of the Team A players. The official denies the request. Is the official correct?</li> <li>4. Following a time-out, A-1, who is to attempt a free throw, delays outside the semi-circle. The official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct?</li> <li>5. As the teams come on the floor to start the game, the Referee notices that all Team A players have mouth guards. The Referee rules that mouth guards are illegal equipment. Is the Referee correct?</li> <li>6. A-2, who is in the frontcourt, deflects A-1's throw-in into the backcourt. A-3 is the first to touch the ball in the backcourt. The official rules a legal play. Is the official correct?</li> <li>7. A-1's throw-in is caught by A-2 while A-2 is straddling the division line. A-2 fumbles the ball into the frontcourt and recovers the ball while still straddling the division line. The official rules a backcourt violation. Is the official correct?</li> <li>8. A-1, while attempting a jump shot, is fouled by B-1. As the whistle sounds, the horn also sounds indicating time has expired in the quarter. A-1 continues the throwing motion, releases the ball and the ball goes through the goal. The official disallows the goal and awards A-1 two free throws. Is the official correct?</li> <li>9. A-1 is disqualified for committing his/her fifth foul. While on the bench, A-1 acts in an unsportsmanlike manner. The official charges the head coach with a direct technical foul. Is the official correct?</li> <li>10. While the ball is in the air on a jump ball to start the first extra period, B-2 intentionally fouls A-2. The official instructs the scorer to set the possession arrow when the ball is at the disposal of A-2 for the first free throw. Is the official correct?</li> <li>11. A-1's dribble strikes B-1's foot causing the ball to bounce away from A-1. A-1 recovers the ball by catching it with both hands and begins to dribble. The official rules an illegal dribble. While the ball is at the disposal of A-1 for a throw-in, A-2 is charged with a common foul. Team B is in the bonus. The official rules a team-control foul. Is the official correct?</li> <li>14. While the ball is in flight on a pass from A-1 to A-2, a double personal foul is ruled. The official awards the ball to Team A nearest to where A-1 was last in contact with the ball. Is the official correct?</li> <li>15. The coach of Team B believes that headbands can only be a maximum of two inches wide. The Referee rules that headbands can be a maximum of three inches wide. | 23. | Yes | No | 23. During warm-ups, the Referee notices that some players have rolled the waistband on their shorts. The Referee notifies the coach that this is an infraction and those players will not be allowed to enter the game. Is the official correct?   |
| 24. | Yes | No | 24. With three-tenths of a second remaining in the game, Team A is awarded the ball out of bounds under their basket with Team B leading 50-49. Team A is not in the bonus. A-1 lobs a pass to A-2, who taps the ball toward his/her basket. While airborne, A-2 is fouled before the signal sounds indicating time has expired. The tap is unsuccessful. The official rules A-2 was fouled in the act of shooting and awards two free throws. Is the official correct? |

Before the officials' jurisdiction has ended, A-1 is charged with a technical foul. Neither free throw is successful. The official rules the game is over. Is the official correct?  |
